

RCM REPORT IEFA. December 2020

- RD/RDA report: Proposed procedure to submit CAR motions. Regional groups a minimum of 12 weeks prior to submission deadline. So cal areas a minimum of 8 weeks. Region at RSC a minimum of 4 weeks. This proposal would enable Issues to begin at a meeting level and move up to SCRAW instead of trickling down to the groups.
