- RD/RDA report: NAWS financials: A financial report has been released from December 2020. Literature sales are still down 20% below the emergency budget and only 62% of the previous December. Contributions from recurring contributors have gone from 54 regular contributors in February of 2020 to 732 recurring contributors in February 2021. They expect recurring contributions to reach \$20,000.00 per month very soon.
